

How to download draft statistics

1. Click on 'CIPFASTATS' in the menu bar, this will take you to the CIPFAstats section of the Research and Statistics website.
2. Now click on 'DRAFT STATISTICS' on the sub menu bar, as shown below.

Datasets and publications provide financial and non-financial information for local government managers engaged in comparative analysis and performance measurement and users of www.cipfastats.net have access to more than ten years of downloadable data, in addition to a range of interactive and visual tools to help with their analysis of the numbers.
